PARISH NEWS

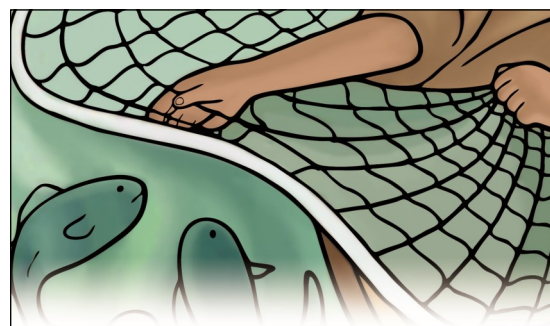
