PARISH NEWS

SUMMER COLLECTIONS: Please be aware that we have payroll each and every month. The last 4 weeks our collections have averaged \$4,000 - \$5,000. That is less than half of what we need to operate. Each month salaries at Sacred Heart are \$90,000 including benefits and insurance, etc. We have used most of the Fall Gala monies as well as taken \$50,000 from the interest on our endowment fund. When those monies are gone we'll have some big decisions to make. Please consider all of this as we go through the rest of the summer months.

PARISH OFFICE CLOSED ON MONDAYS: The parish office will be closed on Mondays during the months of June and July.
